We will adhere to these guidelines, and we expect you to as well.

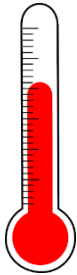
Please read the full COVID19 policy before you make you payment.

The following are some important points to remember:



Your Child Should Stay Home If they exhibit any of the following symptoms:



- Fever over 99.5 degrees
- Coughing
- Shortness of breath
- Diarrhea
- Stomach Upset of any kind
- Runny Nose/Congestion
- Fatigue
- Malaise



What is screening?

- Temperature check
- Overall assessment of child's condition
- A series of questions by Head Teacher
- Verification no medication has been administered to mask any symptoms

Parent Drop-Off and Pick-Up

- ✓ Parents will drop off/pick up children outside of the classroom. Head Teachers will do morning screening checks
- ✓ We will have designated spots outside to ensure parents social distance during drop-off and pick-up



What if we don't pass screening?

You will be asked by the teachers to return home, and come back when the child has been symptom free for 72 hours and the head teacher agrees the child's condition has improved sufficiently at the next screening



Changes in the Classrooms

- ✓ Limited Class Sizes
- ✓ Same Teachers Everyday
- ✓ Classes cannot combine
- ✓ Individual sensory play
- ✓ Social distancing as much as possible in the classroom
- ✓ Teachers Daily Health Screening
- ✓ Health Screenings and Checks throughout the day for children
- ✓ Face coverings when needed
 - ✓ Hand washing practices increased
- ✓ Cleaning and disinfection increased



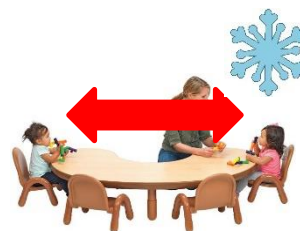
- ✓ New openable windows and doors installed to promote air circulation in the classrooms

NEW Strict Exclusion Policy

Please be sure to read the policy thoroughly



- ✓ No lunch service
- ✓ Tables and chairs spread apart
- ✓ Towels used to mark the area for children during circle/story times
- ✓ Activities held outdoors as much as possible



If a case of COVID19 is detected, immediate closure of school - strict 14 day self monitoring period for symptoms and cleaning/disinfection of the school.



Please Note: closure may also occur if directed by Embassy Management reflective of C19 response phase

How You Can Help at Home

Practice the following 3 things with your child to help them be safe at school:

1. 20 second handwashing that scrubs the front and back of the hands including thumbs, in between fingers and under fingernails
2. Sneezing and coughing into the crook of the elbow or tissue and immediate handwashing afterward
3. Keeping fingers out of noses, mouths and eyes
